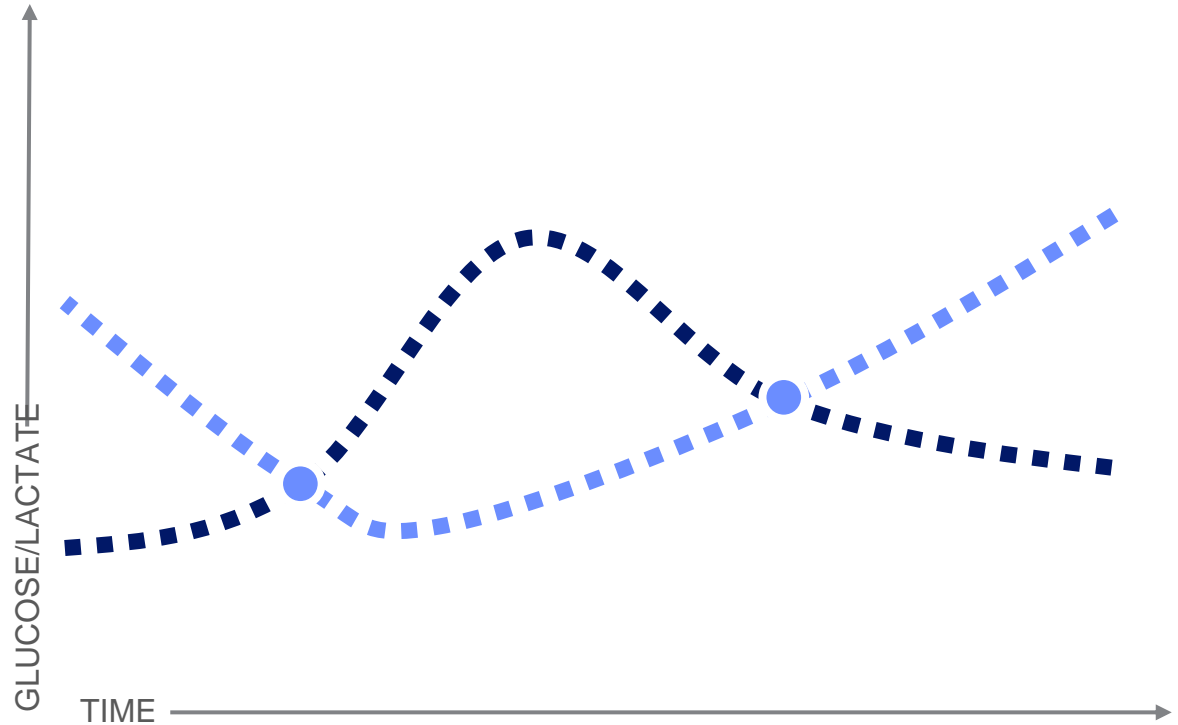

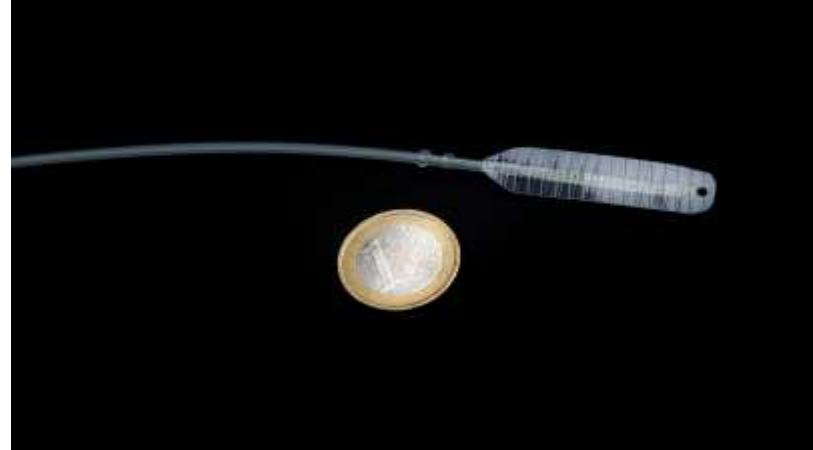
Instrument with biosensor


System consisting of a sensor and instrument; accessing blood/plasma/liquid via a sampling line
