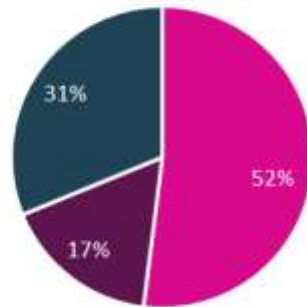

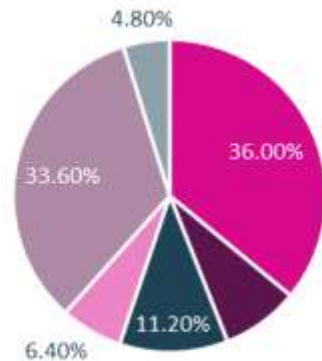
Primary Business repartition in Cambridge

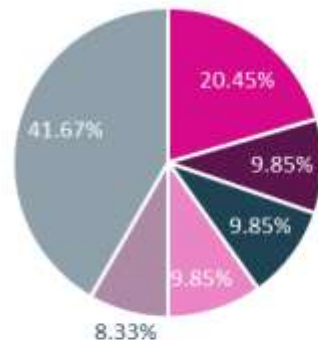
Technology repartition in Cambridge

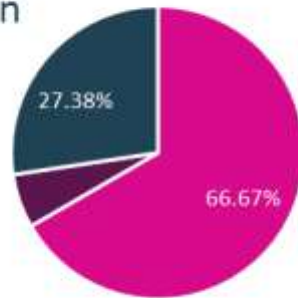

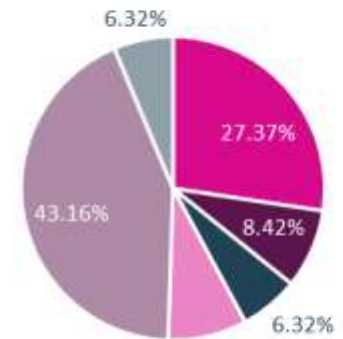
Primary business repartition in London

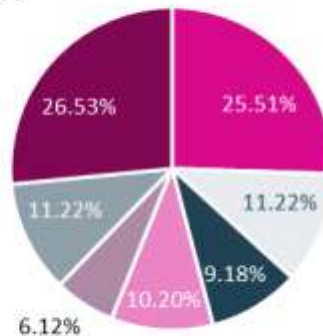
Technology repartition in London
